As a hunter or trapper, I agree to conduct myself as a professional and accept the responsibilities essential to ensuring a future that includes hunting and trapping.

- 1 I am an invited guest of the landowner and will not hold them responsible for any of my accidents.
- 2 I will respect all property and report any acts of misuse to the proper authority.
- 3 I will support conservation efforts that work towards ensuring our future generations have hunting and trapping opportunities as we do today.
- 4 I will abide by the laws and regulations proclaimed by the State of North Dakota and insist my companions do the same.
- 5 I will work with my peers on educational programs that serve to maintain hunting and trapping as legitimate and beneficial outdoor activities.
- 6 I will respect furbearers and consider animal welfare in my actions.
